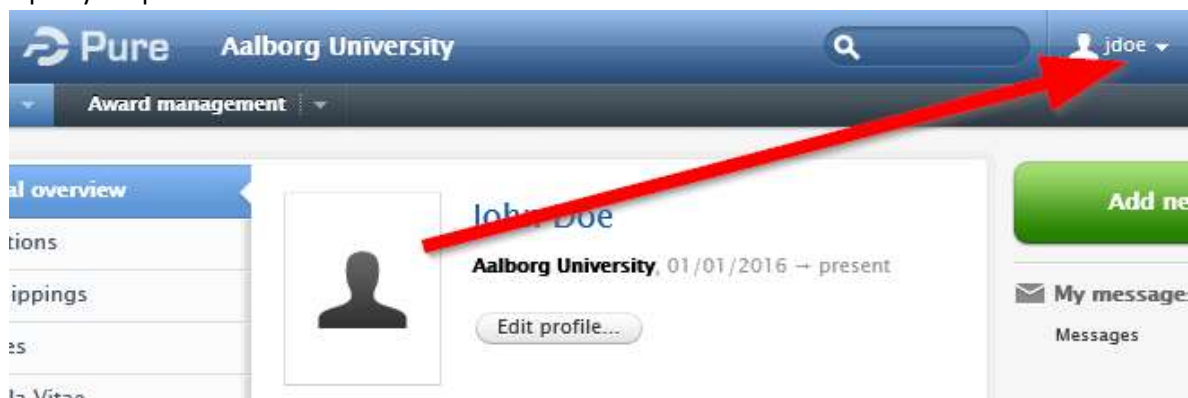


Add Author Identifiers to your Pure profile

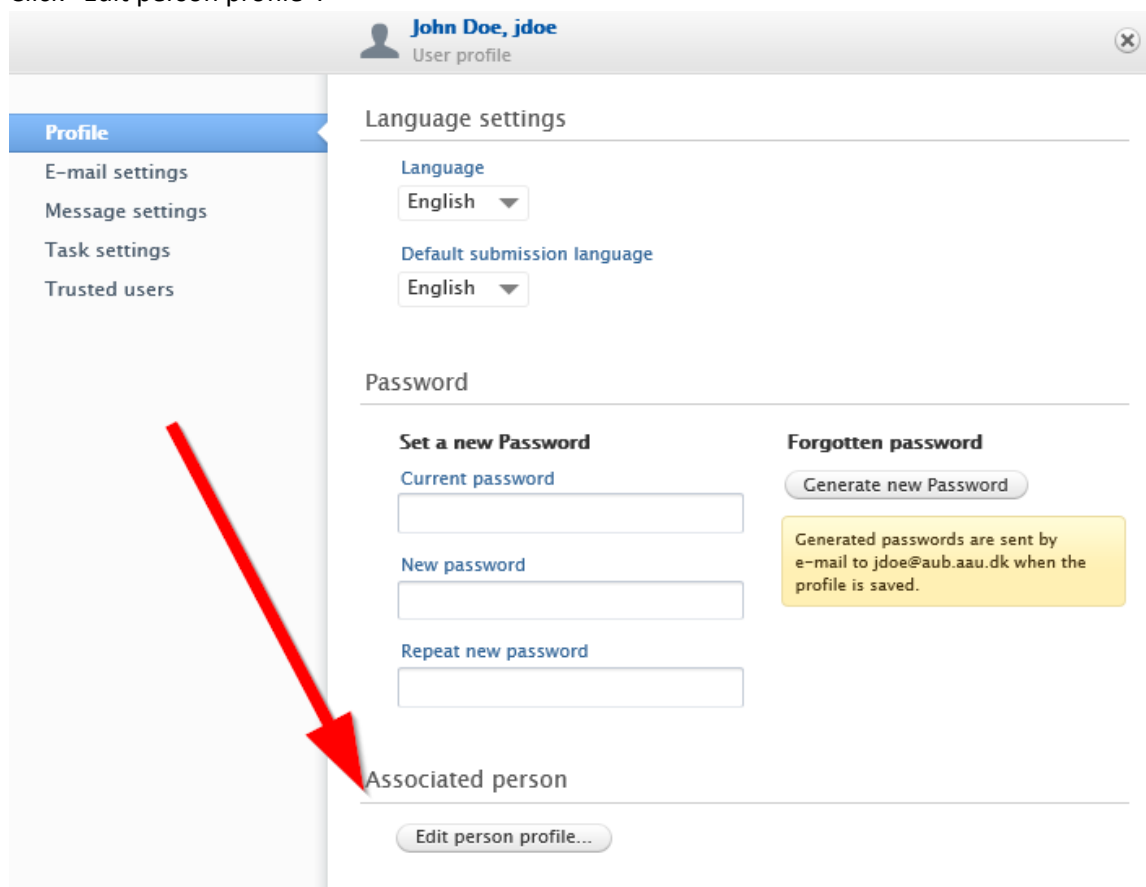
This is a description of how you can add author identifiers to your Pure profile. Author identifiers are ids that may identify you in a unique manner. Examples of author identifiers are ResearcherID, Scopus Author ID and ORCID.

How to:

1. Log in to Pure at <http://vbn.aau.dk/admin>
2. Open your profile editor:



3. Click "Edit person profile":



4. Add ids – by clicking “Add ID”:
